Clever cladding

The use of sandstone blocks as a construction material has a long and enviable history in all states and territories, particularly in New South Wales. At first glance it would appear that the exterior walls of this extensive private residence located in Neutral Bay, Sydney were constructed using sandstone blocks.

In actual fact supply and installation specialists Dalski Stone clad the existing exterior walls with 300 x 600 x 50mm panels of imported sandstone, affixed with Mapei adhesive.

The same material was employed to clad small sections of the property's exterior. Dalski Stone arranged for their supplier to produce customised corner pieces (inset) to effectively finish the return walls. Special 'U' shaped pieces were manufactured to encase existing columns.



Sydney is a city which is virtually built on sandstone. Almost 700 square metres of richly textured, warm and inviting sandstone adds a traditional aesthetic to the surrounds of this superb property.
