Stone shines in Six Star Green Star project

The ANZ Centre – Corporate HQ located in Docklands was designed by architects Hassell and Lend Lease Design. Builders Bovis Lend Lease contracted Baron Forge to fabricate and supply almost 15,000 square metres of imported bluestone paving and cladding, and approximately 3000 square metres of marble which was installed in the executive area located on level 10.

Significantly the ANZ building is Australia's largest tenanted building. The building which houses 6500 staff comprises of 130,000 square metres of floor space located on ten floors.

The ANZ corporate HQ which dominates the Docklands skyline was opened by former state

premier John Brumby. The building won a six-star rating approval from the Green Building Council of Australia. Appropriately it produces 70 per cent less greenhouse emissions than other buildings. By tapping gas-fired energy and on-site solar and wind power, the building will generate much of its own electricity.

Baron Forge completed every facet of the stone installation on time. Use of futuristic 3mm and 6mm low-thickness panels of bluestone cladding was particularly impressive. The processing, delivery and installation of 1.400 tonnes of natural stone impressed Bovis Lend Lease project manager Lachlan Morrison, who described the Baron Forge team as "The best I have worked with."
