Developing the exterior of a property to create a space where the occupants can relax or exercise is becoming attractive to increasing numbers of Australians. Our featured project emphasises the role that natural stone can play in proceedings.

The inviting multi-storey home located in the north Sydney suburb of Northbridge enjoys superb views over Middle Harbour. Ironically the suburb takes its name from its location north of a sandstone suspension bridge which was built at a cost of 42,000 pounds in 1892. The bridge is currently known as Long Gully Bridge.

Dalski Stone supplied and installed over 60 square metres of 600 x 400 x 30 mm sandstone veneers, with a rockface finish, plus a similar quantity of sandstone pavers.

The intricate splayed cutting on the semi-circular treads and risers which descend to the spa is very precise. Dalski Stone's installation team used a combination of Laticrete 217 adhesive and 4237 powder to complete the tiling works.
