Stone Description: **Diamond sawn and sparrow pecked cladding, solid blocks curved and sparrow pecked, plus various feature walls throughout the estate, boulder retaining walls and seating blocks, hand carved features.**

**E**conomic Development Queensland's Residential Development is focused on delivering vibrant, master planned communities across Queensland in a variety of locations.

The Tannum Blue project – located 32 kilometres south-east of Gladstone CBD – commenced in 2012 close to the city's airport. The community will consist of approximately 850 homes, including various house and land options for a variety of family sizes. The nearby foreshore, Boyne River and abundant walking trails will provide healthy living opportunities.

The main entrance is situated on the corner of Dahl and Tannum Sands Road. The statement entry wall is constructed from 50mm diamond sawn and sparrow pecked cladding, which includes a number of curved blocks. All of the stone was supplied by Capricorn Sandstone Quarries; the installation was completed by head contractor Boyd's Bay Landscaping, and Michael Wyatt of Natural Sandstone of Australia.

A variety of sandstone feature walls, boulder retaining walls, seating blocks and attractive hand carved features appear throughout the estate. **05**
